

# New Mexico High School AiS Challenge Cyber-Defenders Institute (CDI)

## Acknowledgement of Rules

---

1. Students will share a hotel room with one or two other students of the same gender. Students must stay in their assigned hotel room from 10:30 pm – 6:30 am unless ordered to leave by adult chaperones, emergency personnel, or hotel staff.
2. Male students may not enter a female student's hotel room unless an adult chaperone is present or gives permission. Likewise, female students may not enter a male student's hotel room unless an adult chaperone is present or gives permission.
3. If a student is given permission to enter a hotel room of a person of the opposite gender, the hotel room door must be propped completely open during the duration of the stay.
4. Students are responsible for all charges to their hotel room except the rental of the hotel room itself. This includes but is not limited to phone charges, room service charges, movie rentals, equipment rentals (microwave, VCR, etc), and damages. Students are encouraged to bring a calling card for personal calls.
5. Students may not leave the hotel grounds or the San Juan College campus without the accompaniment or permission of an adult chaperone.
6. Students may only use transportation provided by the CDI program unless prior arrangements are made with the CDI staff and/or chaperones and permission is granted from the student's parent or legal guardian. Student's who drive themselves to the CDI will NOT be allowed to use their personal vehicle while attending the CDI unless they have specific permission from their parents or legal guardians to do so.
7. Students must attend all classes and scheduled activities during the CDI unless they have the permission of an adult chaperone for absence (sickness, etc).
8. The consumption, use, or possession of drugs, alcohol, or cigarettes is strictly prohibited during any portion of the CDI. Likewise, students may not bring or possess any type of firearm, knife, or other weapon at the CDI.
9. Students who engage in any type of physical violence, vandalism, theft, or any other behavior deemed unbecoming by LANL personnel and/or the adult chaperones may be dismissed from the CDI immediately.
10. Students will be issued a laptop computer for their personal use during the CDI program. Any damages beyond normal wear and tear or loss of the laptop during the CDI will be the sole responsibility of the student. In the event that the student does not accept responsibility of the laptop, they can check the laptop in and out during classroom hours only and will not be able to use it outside of the classroom environment. Students must return the laptops to LANL personnel at the conclusion of the CDI.
11. All interpretations of a student's conduct and subsequent decisions made by LANL personnel and/or the adult chaperones are final. Students must abide by these decisions.
12. Weekend activities will be provided for 7/12 and 7/13 for students that choose to remain in Farmington, and all rules will remain in effect during this time. Students that choose go home over the weekend must arrange their own transportation and have their parent's permission both to return home and for their transportation.

Violations of any of the aforementioned rules will result in consequences up to and including immediate dismissal from the CDI. A student that is dismissed from the CDI will forfeit the \$250 stipend for the completion of the program. Parents will be required to immediately retrieve their student from the CDI, regardless of the time of day.
