The Roundup scheduled in Las Cruces, at Dona Anna CC, will be fully funded by them. We hope to have 15 participants at seven Roundups this summer. We have the \$5K from Google RISE to help cover the costs. A Roundup costs about \$2.5K. We hope to get some support from PED. We want to record some sessions and distribute them over the Web. We should plan to have an STI, via NM CAC gateways, in some fashion. \$40K should be enough to pull off something. We will list the course with NM Tech, but not plan

What is the bare bone minimum for the different events? STI \$40K, Intel Parallel Bootcamp \$11.5K, Staff \$6K/month (plus \$1-3K for outreach staff), Roundups

\$15K (but have \$5K), Kickoff \$40K, (\$25K min), \$5K for AP CS class, \$10K for Sandia/UNM tours, Expo/Awards Ceremony \$40K (\$25K paid by LANL), Scholarships/Internships \$50K, \$172K for events, \$72K for staff plus extras means we need \$290K (plus \$10K for Synergy Teacher evaluation).
