Who is the mission statement for:

people that want to know what we do

Not for the participants, but for grant providers

framework for execution

We support teaching, but we don't teach

! Goal: set up for success by emphasizing computational modeling  
project based research  
presentation skills / report writing

Either the mission statement is wrong, or we need to change what we are doing

Outcomes:

what is wrong with the current projects?

How can we change things to improve outcomes?  
What 'fat' do we need to cut?

Who is our customer?

- companies that providing<sup>e</sup> funding with the expectation that we will produce students capable of filling positions at those companies

Allows students an early access to the skills and tools required → students are good anyway, challenge demonstrates student achievements and talents
